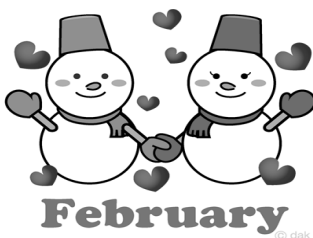

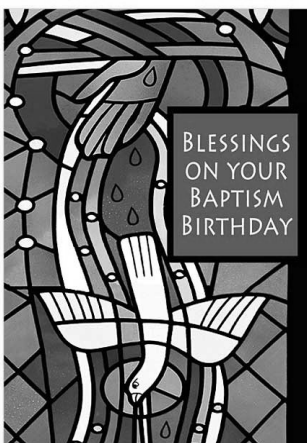

January 12, 2022

Present at meeting: Brad Hoth, Lindelle Scherf, Tammy Muller, Zachary Radloff, and Loretta Weipert. Jeff Klinge and Jeremy Wolfe joined by telephone. Absent: Tracey Phillips

Meeting called to order by President Radloff at 6:33 PM. Opening devotions given by Jeremy.

Loretta moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Brad. Motion carried. Motion to approve the minutes of December 2021 meeting made by Brad, seconded by Loretta. Motion carried. Tammy moved to accept the treasurer's report, seconded by Brad. Motion carried.

Lay Minister Report: Jeremy is working with the youth to get registered for the 2022 Youth Gathering in Minneapolis July 24-28. Luana has none and Farmersburg has 4 youth interested at this time.

Ongoing Business:

Due to high numbers of COVID and the cold & flu season, restrictions & practices will remain in effect.

Internet service at the church is extremely slow. Upon inspection of the bill, we are at the lowest level. Lindelle will check into upgrading the plan.

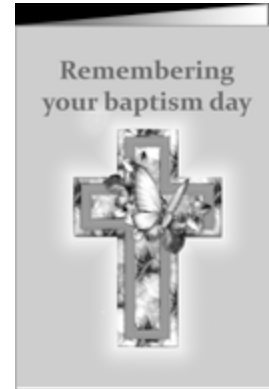

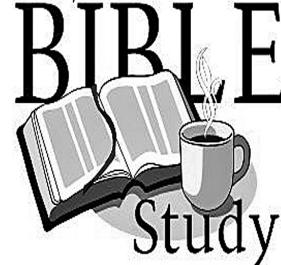

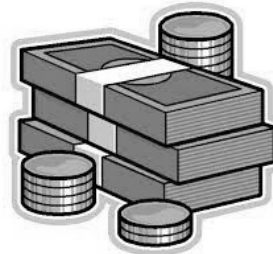

Upon her arrival, Penelope was able to build a relationship with the new LSI Spiritual Life Leader, Pastor Kyle. The voluntary Spiritual Life program connects youth on Bremwood's campus to faith-based music and art, youth group, and chapel sessions. After Pastor Kyle had begun to settle into his new call with LSI, he began hosting a worship service each week for children on campus centered around the eucharist. Penelope enjoyed participating in worship and encouraged her peers to join in.

One day while talking with Penelope, Pastor Kyle asked her what got her so excited about worship and why she encouraged her peers to attend.

As Pastor Kyle continued the conversation with Penelope, the two discussed the importance of communion and how being fed through the bread of life empowered us to live amongst and for our neighbors.
