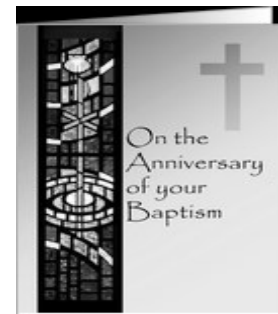

**Next Meeting: September 10, 2023 @7:30am**



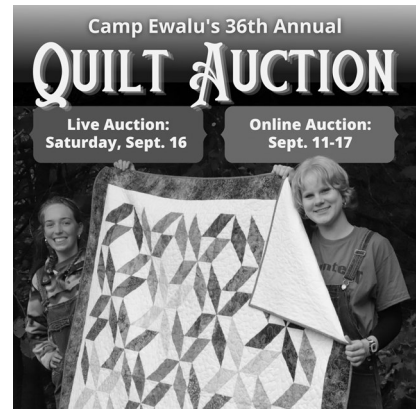

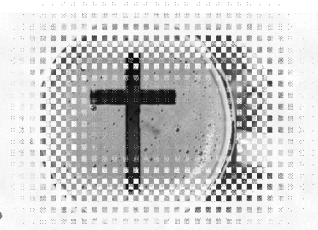

We will defiantly need them for next year. Thank you for your continued compassion for our children and the programs we host for them. It takes all of us to make good things great!

Our Annual Hog Roast will be held October 1, 2023 from 4pm- 7pm at the Auditorium in St. Olaf. We will be serving pulled pork sandwiches, beans, cheesy potatoes, salads, deserts and beverages. ### Clothing center updates
