Advent is already here. Can you believe it? Maybe you love the cold weather and maybe you don't but either way advent has a way of sneaking up on you. Advent means arrival or coming and during advent we celebrate his arrival in multiple ways. Obviously he arrived to us about two-thousand years ago in the most humble way imaginable. Son (or assumed to be) of a carpenter and born in a stable in humble Bethlehem. God became man and Immanuel (God is with us) was born. We don't have too much detail about his early life and there is a gap between age 12 and age 30 but once he began his ministry... what a powerful ministry it was and is! We celebrate his humble arrival as a babe in the manger, we celebrate his arrival as King of Kings and Lord of Lords, and we wait for a time when all things are made new.

When you look at the Christmas story there are some characters in the background that make an impact, for better or for worse. The wise men of the east. Herod. Simeon. Mary. Joseph. The shepherds. The angels. Zechariah, Elizabeth, and John the Baptist. Yes John the Baptist is a character in the Christmas story too. He leapt in Elizabeth's womb!

During Advent you and I will explore some of these characters and the impact that they had on the Christmas story. Most of them are relatable. As Lutherans we enjoy the journey but at the end of the day we are always focused on the cross. Our hopes and reconciliation with God can be found there and when we celebrate advent we celebrate that arrival and that Emmanuel (God with us) spirit. We want him with us all of the time and thank God that he arrived here, lived a sinless life, and then died for us so that we could have an abundant life both now and in eternity. It's truly a time to be thankful. Advent blessings to you. I leave you with the words that the angel of the Lord gave to Joseph when the blessing of Jesus was revealed to him:

20 But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." 22 All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet: 23 "Look, the virgin shall become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, "God is with us." (Matthew 1:20-23 NRSV)






